

The book includes a series of reviews of the development of social policy since the establishment of the People's Republic of China. It looks at the effect of the economic system, the mode of production and forms of employment for social policy design, to clarify the developing context of Chinese social policy, and to help readers grasp the legal aspects of social policy development and the main problems China faces in its present economic developmental stage.

This event will be an opportunity to discuss how to ensure sustainability and adequacy of social security systems, and what the future of pension policy in the context of future of work should be.

Prof Dr. Zhou Hong, member of the Academic Divisions of Chinese Academy of Social Sciences (CASS), serves as Deputy Chair of the Academic Division for International Studies of CASS.
